

Cookie Policy

What are Cookies?

In common with many other website operators, we use standard technology called 'cookies' on our website. Cookies are small text files that are placed on your devices by websites that you visit. They are widely used in order to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the site.

The table below explains the cookies we use and why.

What cookies do we use?

We use the following cookies:

Cookie Name	Purpose and nature of cookie	Any personal data collected by the cookie
charitable_session	<p>This plugin tracks website behaviour between the Charitable donation plugin and the payment gateway to ensure secure status of the application before any transactions are made.</p> <p>The plugin is essential to allow the site to securely process a donation when instructed by the user.</p>	<p>This plug-in identifies a user's device only (not any other personal information) in order to identify the actions they have taken when choosing to make a donation through the site.</p> <p>The legal basis we rely on to process this data is for the purposes of our legitimate interests of securely processing donations.</p>
cookie_status	<p>This cookie stores the status of the cookie banner message that appears when you first use this website so a user does not need to select the banner upon each visit.</p> <p>This cookie essential in order to remember the selection actively made by the user for the site.</p>	<p>This identifies a user's device only (not any other personal information), in order to only show their cookie banner message once they have selected and agreed to close the cookie message.</p> <p>The legal basis we rely on to process this data is for the purposes of our legitimate interests of remembering the selection the user made.</p>
modalsDismissed	<p>This cookie stores the status when the user has dismissed a website overlay after their first visit to the site in order to prevent the overlay being shown again.</p>	<p>This cookie identifies a user's device only (not any other personal information), in order to only show newsletter pop up once the user has interacted or dismissed the message.</p>

	This cookie essential in order to remember the selection actively made by the user for the site to remember their choice.	The legal basis we rely on to process this data is for the purposes of our legitimate interests of storing your overlay choices.

We use the information to compile reports and to help us improve the website. The cookies collect information in an anonymous form, including the number of visitors to the website and blog, where visitors have come to the website from and the pages they visited. More information available on Google: https://support.google.com/analytics/answer/6004245	The data collected for Google Analytics identifies a device type and location (Town or City), but not data or personal information about the user themselves, and it does not identify a specific device. It is collected to serve the purpose detailed adjacent, to support the running and performance of our site and optimising its performance for the user. The legal basis we rely on to process this data is our legitimate interests of tracking the number of visitors to the website, to identify where visitors have come to the website from, and the pages visited
